Deferred cord clamping - maternity information

If all is well, we will wait at least two minutes before clamping and cutting the cord The baby can still be placed skin to skin, for example on the mother's chest (if the cord is long enough) If the baby is higher than the level of the placenta, blood flow is slightly slower as the blood has to be pushed 'uphill' In this case we may wait slightly longer (up to five minutes) before
